General Rules

Engineering Student Council (ESC) will be awarding money to the Registered Student Organizations (RSOs) who are most active in our events. Judging will be based on a point system, which reflects participation, organization and event enthusiasm, and for placement in the event. Most of the events are competitive events, in which most points are for participation and the rest are for placement. RSOs are encouraged to use members of their organization. However, all SIUC students are welcome to participate in these campus-sponsored events. Any subjective decision made regarding to points or placement will be done by the executive board members. Events that are currently scheduled are outlined in this packet. Each event includes a list of the possible points for that event.

Engineering Banquet:

Tuesday, February 21, 2006 -OR- Wednesday, February 22, 2006

This is the annual Banquet for the College of Engineering. It is held during engineering week and it is expected that all engineering RSOs attend. Tickets must be purchased in advance and normally cost under \$5.00.

Event Points:

- 5 points will be awarded for each ticket sold by the RSO

Engineering Day:

Thursday, February 23, 2006

This annual event is hosted for area high school. RSOs are station throughout the engineering building hosting activities for the student to do. Each RSO is expected to have an activity, but can collaborate with another RSO.

Event Points:

- 50 points will be awarded if the RSO sponsors an event
- 5 points per hour will be awarded to each person

Can Castle

Wednesday, November 9th

The main objective is to collect canned goods to build a castle of canned goods. The items collected will be donated to a local charity. Can good drop off is scheduled to begin at 8:00 am. The quantity of cans will be calculated at 1:00pm. The judging of castle design and height measurement will be executed at 4:00pm by the College of Engineering Faculty and ESC executive board.

Event Points:

- 15 points for RSO participation
- 5 bonus points for Team Uniform or Saluki Wear
- Overall points awarded for highest total score:
 - ✓ 20 points for 3rd place
 - ✓ 25 points for 2nd place
 - ✓ 30 points for 1st place

Total score will be calculated by the following formula.

$$(\text{Total Number of Cans}) + \text{Design Points} + 2(\text{Height}) - 10(\text{damage cans}) = \text{Total score}$$

Design Points

- 1st- 50 points
- 2nd- 35points
- 3rd- 20 points
